

#### **Rules refresher**

#### **Preferred lies:**

If we are playing preferred lies, for example say 30cm preferred lies; the process is...

- 1. Mark your ball
- 2. Pick it up yes, you can clean it
- 3. Take preferred lie within a 30 cm semi-circle NO nearer the hole
- 4. Hit a great shot!

NB: Fairways only means fairways; through the green means everywhere EXCEPT penalty areas & bunkers

#### Gentle reminders...

#### **Golfing Etiquette:**

Please remember that as members of the IGC you are representing our Club and our Community when visiting our Host Golf Clubs. Our behaviour, dress, etiquette, language, and observance of all the rules of golf should always be in tune with our surroundings. Your assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated.

#### Course Care:

Replace/repair divots, rake bunkers, fix pitch marks, watch your pace of play, keep up with the group in front – not ahead of the group behind.

#### Scorecards:

Are to be agreed & signed on completion of the round NOT in the clubhouse. No adjustments will be made by committee members on MiScore App.

#### Attire:

Players to wear Club Shirts & Cap at all IGC Sydney Games as well as respecting local Golf Clubs dress codes, course etiquette and mobile phone policies.

#### **IGC Prizes & Trophies:**

#### Daily Prize:

- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> each grade
- 2<sup>nd</sup> only awarded if field is > 5
- 3<sup>rd</sup> only awarded if field is > 10
- 1<sup>st</sup> for 2BBB team event
- Players can only win one prize.

#### Notes:

- Lou Sorrenti Memorial Trophy: Aggregate best 6 stableford scores for 2023 (min. 8 games played)
- Nick Scali and Piero Nonnis trophy events will have a maximum applicable handicap of 36.
- 2BBB 2 -person team event played in conjunction. Best Ball, Aggregate, or Multiplier set on the day.
- 2BBB Is the better stableford score of the two players on each hole.
- 2BBB Aggregate is the sum of the two players stableford scores over 18 holes.
- 2BBB Multiplier is the multiplication of the two players stableford scores on each hole.

#### Prizes Order:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place 2BBB
- 1<sup>st</sup> Individual A, B & C grade
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Individual A, B & C grade
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Individual A, B & C grade

#### Grades:

- Based on Day HCP
- A Grade +8 to 12
- B Grade 13 to 19
- C Grade 20 to 36
- D Grade > 36

#### Hole in One Competition rules

#### "SUPPLIED BY DRUMMONDS GOLF STANMORE"

- 1. Player must be a current financial member of the Italian Golf Club Sydney Limited.
- 2. First attempt at the hole, by each individual player, is valid only.
- 3. Only on a Par 3 hole of a minimum 150 meters to be nominated by the committee prior to the start of the game.
- 4. Compulsory, "CALL UP" by previous group, on the nominated hole were possible.
- 5. An IGC member/Playing group must attest and witness the shot.
- 6. In the event of a dispute the final decision is at the absolute discretion of the IGC committee.
- 7. Any foul play will result in the instant termination of the member from the IGC Sydney Limited club.

Definition of a "Hole-in-One".

"A hole-in-one occurs when a ball hit from a tee to start a hole, finishes in the nominated cup. A ball hit from a tee following a lost ball, out of bounds, or water hazard is not a hole in one".
