

A quick note on your daily handicaps, they do change depending on the course and the tees of the day hence the difference to what you may be used to at your home club. Handicaps are regulated through the Golf Australia (GA) system and cannot be adjusted by us. Believe it or not Monash was rated by GA as a Slope of 132 par 72 so it would have been close to your GA Hcp.

Next month on Thursday 13th April we will be at Twin Creeks for the first round of the 2023 Club Championships with a shot gun start at 12 noon. As daylight saving will have ended, we need to ensure we have the best opportunity to be complete and back no later than 5pm, we will close the registration desk 20 minutes prior to tee-off briefing at 11.45 and move to tees at 11.50, your cooperation is appreciated in advance.

Golfing Etiquette:

Please remember that as members of the IGC you are representing our Club and our Community when visiting our Host Golf Clubs. Our behaviour, dress, etiquette, language, and observance of all the rules of golf should always be in tune with our surroundings. Your assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Course Care:

Replace/repair divots, rake bunkers, fix pitch marks, watch your pace of play, keep up with the group in front – not ahead of the group behind.

Scorecards:

Are to be agreed & signed on completion of the round NOT in the clubhouse. No adjustments will be made by committee members on MiScore App.

IGC Prizes & Trophies:

Daily Prize:

- 1st, 2nd 3rd each grade
- 2nd only awarded if field is > 5
- 3rd only awarded if field is > 10
- 1st for 2BBB team event
- Players can only win one prize.

Prizes Order:

- 1st place 2BBB
- 1st Individual A, B & C grade
- 2nd Individual A, B & C grade
- 3rd Individual A, B & C grade

Grades:

- · Based on Day HCP
- A Grade +8 to 12
- B Grade 13 to 19
- C Grade 20 to 36
- D Grade > 36

Notes:

- Lou Sorrenti Memorial Trophy: Aggregate best 6 stableford scores for 2023 (min. 8 games played)
- Nick Scali and Piero Nonnis trophy events will have a maximum applicable handicap of 36.
- 2BBB 2 -person team event played in conjunction. Best Ball, Aggregate, or Multiplier set on the day.
- 2BBB Is the better stableford score of the two players on each hole.
- 2BBB Aggregate is the sum of the two players stableford scores over 18 holes.
- 2BBB Multiplier is the multiplication of the two players stableford scores on each hole.

- 1. Player must be a current financial member of the Italian Golf Club Sydney Limited.
- 2. First attempt at the hole, by each individual player, is valid only.

- 3. Only on a Par 3 hole of a minimum 150 meters to be nominated by the committee prior to the start of the game.
- 4. Compulsory, "CALL UP" by previous group, on the nominated hole were possible.
- 5. An IGC member/Playing group must attest and witness the shot.
- 6. In the event of a dispute the final decision is at the absolute discretion of the IGC committee.
- 7. Any foul play will result in the instant termination of the member from the IGC Sydney Limited club.

Definition of a "Hole-in-One".

"A hole-in-one occurs when a ball hit from a tee to start a hole, finishes in the nominated cup. A ball hit from a tee following a lost ball, out of bounds, or water hazard is not a hole in one".
