Congratulations to those players that have progressed to the Matchplay quarter finals. Good luck to all!

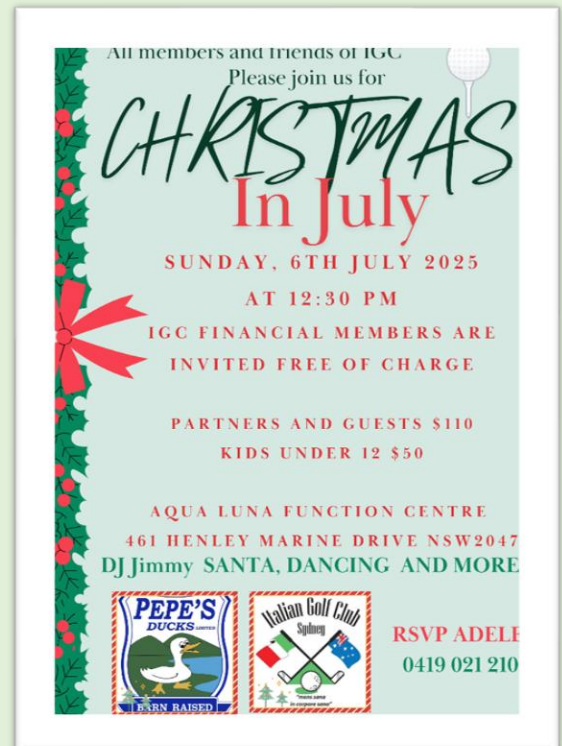
Our next game is at Campbelltown Golf Club Thursday 19th June with an 11.00 am Shotgun Start.

Captain's Report

- C – Grade Runner Up: - John Torrisi (20) 36 pts c/b

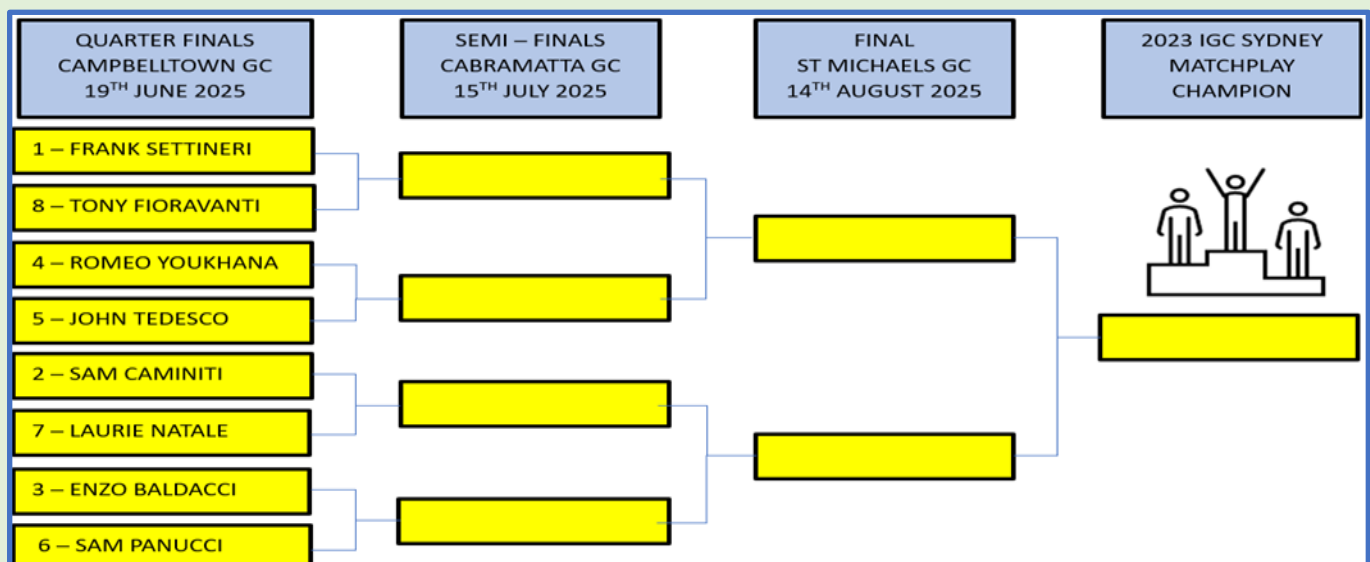


*** NEW CLUB RULE – “the 100 rule” ***

If your **AGE + your GA Handicap** is equal to/greater than 100 you are entitled to tee off from the forward most tees to overcome any significant water or hazard carry on designated holes.

At Campbelltown this will apply on HOLE 1 to avoid the water carry enabling eligible players to tee off from the BRONZE tee

The IGC Sydney Matchplay commences at the Campbelltown Game with the top 8 overall qualifiers (based on Stableford scores) are as follows. If you are unable to play the three rounds please advise the club ASAP, and preferably before the Campbelltown game so a reserve can be elevated in.



Golfing Etiquette

Please remember that as members of the IGC you are representing our Club and our Community when visiting our Host Golf Clubs. Our behaviour, dress, etiquette, language, and observance of all the rules of golf should always be in tune with our surroundings. Your assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Speed of Play:

Speed of play is a major issue as well as being selfish and irritating to everyone. What should **YOU** do: -

- It is **YOUR** responsibility to **keep up with the group in front**, not in front of the group behind
- If you think it's a lost ball **hit a provisional immediately**
- The rules are you have **3 minutes to look for a ball**
- Don't wait to the others have hit to prepare for your shot! **Ready Golf – play if safe to do so**
- If you can score on the hole **pick up**
- Don't park buggies in front of greens blocking following groups
- Score at the next tee not on the green

Course Care:

Replace/repair divots, rake bunkers, fix pitch marks, watch your pace of play, keep up with the group in front – not ahead of the group behind.

Scorecards:

As a marker it is your responsibility to score the player whilst ensuring fair play and to protect the interests of every other player in the field. Scores on a hole should be agreed prior to hitting of on the next hole. Are to be agreed & signed on completion of the round NOT in the clubhouse. No adjustments will be made by committee members on MiScore App.

Attire:

Players to wear Club Shirts & Cap at all IGC Sydney Games, tailored pants/shorts with shirts tucked in plus the Club's dress codes, course etiquette and mobile phone policies of the day.

Hole in One Competition

Definition of a "Hole-in-One".

"A hole-in-one occurs when a ball hit from a tee to start a hole, finishes in the nominated cup. A ball hit from a tee following a lost ball, out of bounds, or water hazard is not a hole in one".

RULES

1. Player must be a current financial member of the Italian Golf Club Sydney Limited.
2. First attempt at the hole, by each individual player, is valid only.
3. Only on a Par 3 hole of a minimum 150 meters to be nominated by the committee prior to the start of the game.
4. Compulsory, "CALL UP" by previous group, on the nominated hole were possible.
5. An IGC member/Playing group must attest and witness the shot.
6. In the event of a dispute the final decision is at the absolute discretion of the IGC committee.
7. Any foul play will result in the instant termination of the member from the IGC Sydney Limited club.
